

Proposals for revised water sector legislation

Athens, 28th September 2018











→ The Partnership shall develop a general position (paper) which can be used as inputs into ongoing and upcoming revisions of EU strategies on water and wastewater, to enable cities to re-use waste water.



EU revision of regulations – status

- → Recent proposal for a "Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on minimum requirements for water reuse"
- → Proposal of minimum requirements (Annex I)

→ Reuse for agricultural purposes



- → Annex I: requirement for agricultural irrigation according different types of crops:
 - Class A) food crops consumed raw;
 - B) food crops where the edible part is not in direct contact with water or processed food;
 - C) food crops where the edible part is not in direct contact with water or processed food (drip irrigation only);
 - D) use of reclaimed water for industrial or energy purposes.
